


GRIMSBY CO-OPERATIVE PRESCHOOL

The survey questions were developed to answer the inquiry:


Are we achieving the goals of our program statement by prioritizing belonging, well-being, engagement, and expression in all aspects of the

Did Not Respond 38.4%

Responded 61.6%





The survey results indicate that families (96%+) feel valued by the program, have a strong sense of belonging and the majority of families are comfortable participating in activities/experiences offered through the program.

"Always offering to help."


"I like the safety considerations and updates through the app regarding extreme weather."

The responses to the survey show that the majority (96%) of families feel welcome and safe to share their perspectives, ideas, and suggestions.




Communication through himama has been a game-changer and appreciated by both staff and families! The streamlined billing, messaging, and updates have made administrative tasks simple.

"I really like the products and companies chosen for the fundraisers and like supporting you guys by buying items from these places even though I've gone for the opt out option."




Each family chooses **ONE** of the two options:

"Love the staff, very personable and easy to communicate with"


